Research club for each batch of MBBS students is formed by the department of Community Medicine to motivate the students to pursue research. The activities are curated in such a way that provides hands on experience in designing, conducting, and presenting research. In addition to these activities workshops are organized periodically for CRMIs covering hands on session on various statistical softwares, Manuscript writing and Critical appraisal of Journal articles. Following these activities, several students have come forward with research proposals and some proposals have even got selected for ICMR research grant. Training is also given to the students to do Systematic Literature Review, a higher level in evidence synthesis.
